

**\*\*IMMUNIZATION REMINDER FOR ALL TMA FAMILIES\*\***

Immunization requirements for school entry help ensure that most children are protected against disease. Because contagious diseases spread among susceptible people, immunization decreases the chance of infection and outbreaks of disease in schools by decreasing the number of unprotected people who may be infected and subsequently transmit the disease. Indiana state law has a minimum requirement for immunizations prior to the first day of the 2019-2020 school year. This is outlined in your child's health record form that will be sent to you by mail with your summer information packet. **All students are expected to be in accordance with these requirements prior to the first day of school.**



Medical exemptions are allowed when a medical contraindication exists. Religious exemptions are allowed when immunizations contradict the parent's sincere religious beliefs. Proper paperwork is required to be on file in the school office for either exemption. During disease outbreak, non-immunized children will be excluded from school and/or activities related to school until the outbreak is over, both for their protection and for the protection of others.
